

WCC Kids Code of Conduct

Warrandyte Community Church is a safe place where children and young people can come together and feel included and have fun.

We encourage children to:

- Be kind to everyone
- Comfort friends and family when they are sad
- Use nice words to encourage others
- Say sorry when they hurt someone and mean it
- Share with others
- Be a positive example of WCC Kids
- Listen to the leaders when instructed

Behaviour that is NOT tolerated for children:

- Fighting with others
- Words that hurt others
- Throw toys or rocks at other people
- Be a bully

We encourage leaders/adults to:

- Use appropriate language
- Be an example of WCC
- Help the children in a safe and inclusive environment
- Allow the children to be vulnerable and never be alone in a room with a child on your own
- Follow the Child Safe Standards and report any negative behaviour or concerns

Behaviour that is NOT tolerated for leaders/adults:

- Being aggressive with a child
- Swearing Infront of children and young people
- Asking children to keep secrets
- Not reporting or acting on any negative behaviour or concerns
